The theme for this newsletter is **Strengthen**. This follows the theme from our last Team Meeting .


In this edition we aim to provide stories about people who are making a difference and provide information about the Bravo Team and the disability sector.

NDIS Update Roll-out Dates and Areas

People can start the access process up to 6 months before the official roll-out date. Even if approved, your plan will not be funded (so you can start paying for supports) until at least from the roll-out date.

If you are an existing Disability Services (State) client you will be contacted by the NDIA, if not, or you are not sure then call 1800 800 110.

Of note: Information on existing people in QLD and Commonwealth disability programs is being passed on securely to the NDIA, so they can make contact to transition people over to the NDIS.

If the Department of Communities, Child Safety, and Disability Services does not have a contact number then that person's information is not passed on to the NDIA - it is important for participants to make sure the Department has phone contact details for you. If you are a carer or guardian of someone with a disability make sure they have your contact details also.

- 1 July 2018 Brisbane, Cairns & Tablelands, Cape York, Torres Strait, Fraser Coast, North and South Burnett, Cherbourg, Logan and Redlands & Gold Coast.
- **1 January 2019 -** Sunshine Coast, Noosa, Gympie, Moreton Bay including Strathpine & Caboolture

Morgan's Project

Morgan, with the assistance of his Support Workers had the great experience of creating a timber chair that paired with the one he had created at school a number of years ago.

Thank you for David Lade for the donation of the timber pallets for Morgan's project.



- 1. Morgan separated the timber they needed from the main runners of the pallet and de-nailed the remainder so there were no sharp hazards. Morgan accounted for every used nail which went into the bin, ensuring that each phase of the build was a logical progression to the next.
- 2. Morgan used logical thinking to sort the timber making sure no knots would

weaken the critical parts that would support the chair user discarding cracked pieces and others where sapwood had caused deformations.

3. Sanding was Morgan's most satisfying goal in the construction, as the two piles of timber reflected the work that had been achieved and the

dwindling pile represented the end of that day's task and smoke time.

- 4. Morgan especially liked the achievement of driving the screws with a cordless drill and seeing the result of joined timber like the original chair, but was less enthusiastic about the time taken to get the lengths, angles, drill depth and screw positions correct.
- 5. Morgan demonstrated his versatility, drilling right handed and painting left handed to seal the timber for a long life on the patio.
